Pennsylvania Children of the Wounded and Fallen Patriot Scholarship

The Pennsylvania Children of the Wounded and Fallen Patriot Scholarship is a one-time \$25,000 scholarship awarded to the dependent child of a military service member who was wounded in the line of duty or died while serving with the United States military since September 11, 2001.

Eligibility Criteria

1. The scholarship applicant must be a dependent son or daughter of a military service member who was wounded in the line of duty or died while serving with the United States Military during the time frame of September 11, 2001 to the present. The service member may have served with any branch of the military (Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, Coast Guard) and any component (Active, National Guard, Reserve).
2. Proof of the parent's military service and injury or death must accompany the application. (Example: DD214, DD1300, Death Certificate, Purple Heart Award Certificate, copy of most recent LES, letter from unit, any other documentation that proves parent had applicable military service).
3. Proof of dependency must accompany the application. (Military ID, Birth Certificate.)
4. All applicants must be a current Pennsylvania resident.
5. All applicants must submit a two page essay (page size 8.5" X 11", single spaced, 12 font) on "What it means to be a Patriot" to Mr. Russ Bowman either by email: rbowman@srpsubro.com or mail to address: 711 York Road, Second Floor, Willow Grove, PA 19090 by August 1, 2017.
6. Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors in high school planning to attend an institute of higher learning (college, university, technical or trade school) on a full time basis following high school graduation are eligible to apply for this scholarship.
7. The scholarship will be paid directly to the institute of higher learning on behalf of the student. Payments will be made in equal amounts divided over the number of terms/years the program lasts. After payment of the first installment, future payment installments are contingent upon the student successfully achieving a current term Grade Point Average of 3.0. Student must provide proof of admission and GPA.

***Pre-requisites for this scholarship can be changed at any time by the scholarship grantor.
