Primary elections are the 3rd Tuesday in May, unless it is a Presidential election, then it is in April. General elections are the 1st Tuesday in November. Absentee ballots must be received by November 1st.

To register to vote, a person must be a citizen on the United States for at least one month, be a resident of Pennsylvania and the election district for at least 30 days, and be at least 18 years of age by the date of the election.

To vote in the primary election, a person must be registered 30 days prior to the primary election and be qualified to vote in the primary. To vote in the general election, a person must be registered 30 days prior to the general election.
